Hotel and trip tips

For all flying in to Frankfurt, Stuttgart, Munich, Cologne, Dusseldorf or Hamburg, a two or three day trip to the Loire valley and back can be worked out.

Many teams from different countries join us on the way, so we can arrive in a Cadillac style convoy at Richelieu in the afternoon of Wednesday Sept. 1st.

Our host hotel is a new resort (finished summer 2009) that will give you comfortable accommodation.

Ground and first floors only (no elevator), all with a private terrace and fully equipped kitchen, surrounded by a green forest and a view on the GE parking lot.

You have the possibility to split up the expense by choosing for a 2 or 3 bedroom apartment, sharing with 4 or 6 people.

Mention if you are disabled, ask for a ground floor room.

Note: as of today, Aug. 2009, there is no air-conditioning in the rooms, but normally you will not need that in September.

In the surroundings you will find other accommodation, castles, rooms in private houses and a camping.

But please keep in mind that this GE is in a very rural location, with every evening a party close to the host hotel "Relais du Plessis".

Roads are very dark after 9pm, streetlights are scarce outside town, wine and champagne will have their effect on you.

Thus, 10 km away from the hotel can be a real hazard at night.

I'm sure you can find more exclusive, or cheaper or whatever accommodation, but this resort was chosen first because of the location, and security for driver and cars (gate).

Next to the hotel is a (new) big supermarket, car wash and gas station (also LPG).

Parking security, rally plate, road book and ambiance are included in your registration.

A local garage and towing company will help you (on your own expenses) in case of need, but we advise you to have a road assistance insurance, road map, Euro cell phone and GPS.

We are happy to assist you, but will not be able to serve as a full travel agent.

The amount of participating cars will be limited to 100 (that's a 2 km long line).
